NOMB Chaperone Information

- You must be a member of the NOHS Band Boosters and a parent/guardian of a member in the NOMB
 - Annual cost for membership in the NOHS Band Boosters is \$1.00 per person
- You must have a completed and approved clearances on file with the CVSD
 - Information about how to do this will be provided
- You must be able to attend the events you volunteer to chaperone
 - This sounds obvious, but if you volunteer and then don't show up, it causes problems
 - A "Chaperone Schedule" for the entire season will be made available in August and reminder e-mails are sent out each week
 - **Note:** You might not get assigned for everything you volunteer to do because it is our goal to get as many parents involved as possible
- You must be willing to supervise the students at all times when with the NOMB.
 - Ultimately, this is your main responsibility and should not be taken lightly. A high standard of class and professionalism is expected of the students and it is the role of a chaperone to model this behavior as well as correct those students that may choose to act inappropriately. This includes behavior at school, on the bus and at all times while attending games and/or competitions.
 - Guidelines for how to handle student behavioral issues will be presented at the annual **Chaperone Meeting** held on the **Monday, August 20th at 6:30 pm** in the Band Room. Any volunteers that are unable to attend the meeting, must have a meeting with 2 board members before they will be allowed to chaperone. (This is mandatory)
- You must be willing to follow the rules as well as enforce them.
 - Being a chaperone has its privileges but it also has its limitations. Realize that there are certain guidelines that are expected of all chaperones. For example:
 - No Smoking anywhere near where the students can possibly see you
 - No use of foul language
 - No eating or drinking in the stands at games or competitions **UNLESS** the students are allowed to do so as well
 - No use of cell phones in the stands at games (unless it is an emergency). The students are also not permitted to do this until their 3rd quarter break

Other important information:

- In order to assist in preparations for leaving the school on time, please plan to arrive approximately **one hour** before scheduled departure times.
 - It is your responsibility to stay in contact with Mike Arnold (Booster VP) if you are going to arrive late.
- Only assigned chaperones are allowed to enter an event with the NOMB.
 - Spouses or non-NOMB children will be required to pay an admission fee if the event calls for it. This includes home football games!
- For performances, chaperones may be assigned duties to assist the NOMB in getting on and off the field.
 - If you have physical limitations that could prohibit you from doing this, please let Mike Arnold know in advance!
- There is no specific dress code for NOMB Chaperones.
 - However, all chaperones are encouraged to wear "booster apparel" or "show apparel" from current or past seasons to help designate that you are with our group and show support for the students.
